## TOWARDS YOUTH MOBILITY AND YOUTH ENGAGEMENT FOR ALL

## **JOINT DECLARATION AND PROPOSALS**

We, signatories, NGOs and national bodies, from all over Europe have gathered to foster civic engagement programs at Member States level, encompassing, but not limited to, long term youth volunteering in all its forms, and we,

- Encourage all Member States to develop their own programs, similar to existing Civic Service models (including France, Germany, Italy, and others): full or part time, with both a service and an educational component, as well as material and/or financial support to be accessible to all.
- Call for the creation of a European coordination framework, beyond, complementing and
  associating closely with current representation of interests at EU level, such as the
  European Volunteer Center, but integrating also Public Authorities in charge of present
  and future Member States' programs mentioned above, and major NGOs involved in all
  types of those, for exchanges of best practices and fostering initiatives and cooperation.
- Ask for the increase of the European Solidarity Corps budget, and within it, the increase
  of the "in-country" component to allow experimentation of the above-mentioned
  programs.
- Ask for more flexibility in the Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps, to be able to cofund the mobility of Member States programs participants within Europe, and also allow all young people to have a combined in-country and out-country, long term experience, similar to Erasmus Mundus, within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps.
- Ask for a "youth horizontal priority" within all existing EU funds to make it possible to develop such youth programs easier, and recognize them as a major tool to support the implementation of all EU policies.
